SCHEDULE L – VEHICLE LOG BOOKS

REFERENCE:

RATIONALE:

To allow vehicles with logbooks issued by foreign ASNs to compete in Australia for up to twelve months without the need for a CAMS logbook to be issued.

ACTION:

Amend Schedule L – Vehicle Log Books by adding new Article 10. as follows:

10. Log Book Provisions – Foreign Vehicles

The following provisions shall apply to vehicles which are not permanently kept in Australia.

International Events

Refer FIA International Sporting Code. There is no requirement for a log book to be presented, except that where a log book is issued for a car by an FIA National Sporting Authority (ASN) it shall be presented upon request.

National Events and below

A vehicle log book issued by an ASN other than CAMS may be presented in lieu of a CAMS Vehicle Log Book, subject to the following:

- The vehicle may be used in Australia for a period of 12 months from the first Australian entry in the log book at a CAMS sanctioned event. If the vehicle is used in a motor sport event in another country, which must be noted in the log book, then the 12 month period shall commence again from the next entry in the log book from a CAMS sanctioned event.
- If the vehicle is to be used in Australia beyond the initial 12 months from the date of the first Australian entry in the log book, the car shall be considered to have been imported on a permanent basis and a CAMS log book shall be required from that point in time.
- Where CAMS issues a replacement log book, CAMS may recognise the date of first issue of the original log book in respect of the application of any relevant technical regulations.

If the vehicle is not subject of a log book issued by an ASN, and the vehicle would otherwise be required to be subject of a log book, the vehicle may only be used in competition where the competitor holds a licence issued by an ASN other than CAMS or Motorsport New Zealand. This approval is valid only while competing under the provisions of Article 18 of the ISC on a Foreign Participation Visa.

These provisions do not relate to 5th Category Historic competitions. Refer 5th Category - Historic Cars, General Regulations for requirements.
